Anglo Scandinavian, located in Apopka, FL, was founded in 1983. From the start it has specialized in Hedera, commonly known as ivy. Anglo Scandinavian began by growing and selling ivy cell packs. However, as the company evolved and developed, the product-line was broadened to include unrooted cuttings, both single and double eye. Over the years they have developed over 150 cultivars of Hedera and they continue to add varieties as they are selected and tested for performance and market acceptance.

FEATURES & BENEFITS

Anglo Scandinavian quality has been, and continues to be, the most important objective. To achieve this, tremendous effort and care has been devoted to the continuous improvement of parent stock. Anglo Scandinavian's organizational mission and objective is to produce an improved cutting for each new generation of parent stock, through a process of meticulous selection.

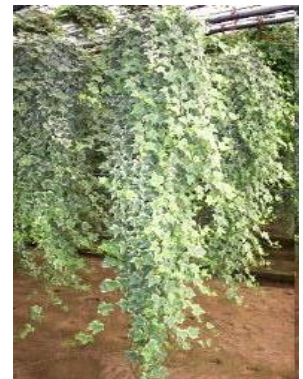
Anglo Scandinavian has pioneered and developed the "bunch" system for unrooted ivy cuttings. Through experimentation and refinement, they have developed a system for grading and bunching that makes for easier, quicker and a more streamline process of sticking directly into the pot. Substantial benefits are also gained in shipping and transportation when the cuttings are shipped in bunches. This can be partially attributed to the fact that their system substantially reduces dehydration and decreases the amount of stress on the cuttings. Anglo Scandinavian continuously strives to improve all aspects of its production and to develop new Hedera products and new ways in which ivy can be used.

KEY ITEMS

Anglo Scandinavian has a multitude of cell pack sizes: 73 cells, 51 cells, 38 cells, and 24 cells.

Not only do they offer cell packs, their product line includes:

- Beautifully hand-formed topiaries in a variety of traditional and contemporary styles, designs using 4", 5", 6", and 8" pot sizes.
- Distinctive grade of unrooted ivy cuttings. The cuttings are available on the vine or in pre-cut form as single or double eye cuttings.
- 3" material in a square, black pot, packed 56 in a box
- 4" material in a round, terra cotta pot, packed 30 in a box
- 6" free-standing in green pots, packed 12 in a box.
- 6" hanging baskets in terra cotta pots, 12 in a box
- 8" hanging baskets in terra cotta pots, packed 6 in a box.
