



PROVIDER PROFILE

Anna Nursery was founded in 1925 by F.G. Anderson, a University of Illinois agronomy graduate. The 240 acres he purchased were used for growing many varieties of strawberry plants, landscape evergreens, and peonies. Thirty-five acres were used as a productive peach orchard. Strawberry plants, and eventually yews were shipped throughout the Midwest to many customers we continue to serve today. As markets changed, more emphasis was put on growing landscape material.

Additional land was purchased in both the 1960's and 1980's, bringing the total to about 400 acres. Anna Nursery began to grow many more varieties of conifers, evergreens, trees and shrubs to meet out customers needs. We also made a change in the 1980's, and started offering container grown stock. Our container production has been increasing steadily over the years, currently reaching over 10 acres.

We have gradually increased our catalog listings over the years, adding many native plants and rare ornamental stock to our product line. Just this year, we have added 37 new varieties. We even grow several plants on Missouri Botanical Garden's 'Plants of Merit' List.

Much has changed over the past 80+ years to the nursery. Each year we manage over 400 acres of land and market over 225 species of trees, plants, and shrubs. We feel our products are the best in the business, partially due to the design, function, and workmanship found at our nursery.

We pride ourselves in providing the highest quality products and continue to add new and improved plants to our product mix. If you're looking for fine quality Midwest product, Anna Nursery might just be the answer for you. We offer materials suited for both the garden center and the landscaper alike.
